The True Call of Ministry (Col. 1:24-29)

- I. The Suffering of Ministry (24)
 - A. Paul Rejoices in His Suffering
 - 1. How many of us suffer in ministry
 - 2. How many of us give up when suffering starts
 - 3. How many of us rejoice when we suffer
 - B. Paul Suffers for Christ's Body
 - 1. He shares Christ's (the body's) suffering in his flesh
 - 2. He shares on behalf of Christ's body (church)
 - 3. He fills the lack in Christ's sufferings
 - i. The enemy can't hurt Jesus
 - ii. The enemy can hurts Jesus' body (church)
 - iii. The enemy has his agents within the church walls
 - iv. The battle is being fought there
- II. The Essence of Ministry (25-28)
 - A. The Stewardship of Ministry (25)
 - 1. He was given this stewardship from God
 - i. It wasn't his decision
 - ii. God called him to do it
 - iii. No matter what happens, he is obedient
 - 2. He was given this for the Church's benefit
 - a. Paul is a minister of the Word
 - i. He is to fulfill the preaching of God's Word
 - ii. He is to benefit the body of Christ with the word
 - b. The Battle is being waged in the church building
 - i. The saved are their needing to be fed
 - ii. The lost are their needing to be saved
 - iii. The wicked are there trying to stop both
 - iv. The best way to stop it is destroy the messenger
 - B. The Substance of Ministry (26-28)
 - 1. Jesus is the Focus of Ministry (26-27)
 - a. He is God's Word Revealed (26)
 - i. He is the mystery hidden in the OT
 - ii. He is the mystery revealed in the NT
 - b. He is God's Word Received (27)
 - i. He is the glory of God's riches
 - ii. He is the fulfillment of Gentile promise
 - iii. He is the hope of glory
 - c. It is hard to focus on sufferings when He suffered so much
 - 2. Jesus is the Gospel Itself (28)
 - a. He is the message
 - i. The Person of Christ is proclaimed
 - a. He is proclaimed with warning
 - b. He is proclaimed by teaching
 - ii. The person of Christ suffered for us

- iii. The preacher models his life after Christ
- iv. The preacher will also suffer because of Him
- b. He is the Fulfillment
 - i. The Person of Christ is the Goal
 - ii. The Person of Christ Completes the believer
 - iii. The Person of Christ is the reward
 - iv. The absence of suffering is not the reward
 - v. The comfort of life is not the reward
 - vi. Christ himself is the reward

This all sounds good and spiritual but how in the world can I actually do it?

III. The Power of Ministry (29)

- A. The Minister Labors for the Purpose of the Gospel
 - a. His work is not about bettering his life or circumstance
 - b. His work is not about bettering his people (physically)
 - i. He must meet felt needs
 - ii. He must comfort and love them
 - iii. He must not make these the focus of ministry
 - iv. He must keep the kingdom and the gospel 1st
- B. The Minister Labors in Christ's Power
 - a. No minister is able to accomplish this
 - b. No human can do it / they will all fail
 - c. Only through the power of Christ can it be accomplished
 - d. Christ gives this power for those He calls
 - e. Many times we fail to work in His strength
- C. The Minister is Mighty Through Christ's Power
 - a. Through His power the minister is unstoppable
 - b. He may lose all but His goal will still be accomplished
