## Faith Manifested – Job 1 (13-22)

- I. Suffering Comes Unexpectedly (13-19)
  - A. Job's World Continues Unaware (13)
    - i. His children continued to feast
    - ii. His servants continued the work
    - iii. His fields were being plowed, his animals cared for (14)
  - B. Job's World is Suddenly Attacked (14-19)
    - i. Job's Prosperity is Exterminated (14-17)
      - 1. Job's Farming Income Destroyed (14-16)
        - \* Evil Men Attack Job's Income
          - Sabeans (Men from Sheba, SW Arabia) Attacked
          - They stole his oxen and donkeys (farming)
          - They killed his servants
        - \* Act of God Attacks Job's Income
          - Fire of God fell on sheep and shepherds
      - 2. Job's Trade Income is Destroyed (17)
        - \* Evil Men Attack Job's Income
          - Chaldeans (SE Mesopotamia, Babylonians)

## Attacked

- Raided his caravans and took them
- They killed his servants
- ii. Job's Family is Exterminated (18-19)
  - 1. His Children are Destroyed by an Act of God
    - \* While they feasted, a wind destroyed the house
    - \* They were killed by a freak storm
- II. Faith's Reaction to Unexpected Suffering (20-22)
  - A. Job's Faith is Manifested (20-21)
    - i. Job grieved deeply (20)
      - 1. Tore robe
      - 2. Shaved head
    - ii. Job worshiped God Deeply
      - 1. Job understood God is God regardless of His circumstances
      - 2. God deserves worship because He is God
      - 3. Not because He gives good blessings
    - iii. Job Trusted God Deeply (21)
      - 1. Job realized He deserved Nothing
        - \*Naked I came, Naked I will go
          - I had nothing, I will have nothing
      - 2. Job realized God is just
        - \* The Lord gives
        - \* The Lord takes away
        - \* The Lord is blessed regardless
  - B. Job's Faith is Vindicated (22)
    - i. Job never sinned by blaming God
    - ii. Job loved God for God, not his blessings
