Faith in Physical Affliction (Job 2:1-10)

- I. The Council is Convened Again (1)
 - A. Sons of God Satan and Angels
- II. Job's Faith is Acknowledged (2-3)
 - A. The Satan was Again Inspecting Humans (2)
 - 1. "Roaming the earth" ... "to and fro"
 - 2. See NET study note (1:7)
 - B. God Challenges Satan Again Regarding Job (3)
 - 1. God reminds Satan of his previous failure with Job
 - 2. God commends Job's Faithfulness
 - 3. God extols Job's reaction to his suffering
- III. Job's Faith is Again Tested (4-10)
 - A. Job's Test is Not Complete (4-6)
 - 1. Satan downplays Job's Faith (4)
 - a. Skin for skin
 - i. Job would be willing to trade others for himself
 - ii. Would Job trade his own skin to keep faith?
 - b. Job's Faith would fail with his health
 - 2. Satan is allowed to Test Job (6)
 - a. Not allowed to kill him
 - b. God is still sovereign in trial
 - B. Job Suffers Greatly (7-8)
 - 1. Job is given boils over his body
 - 2. Job's agony is very great (8)
 - a. He scraped himself with pottery shards for relief
 - b. He has truly lost everything
 - C. Job Sustains His Faith (9-10)
 - 1. Job's Wife counsels him to abandon faith (9)
 - a. She saw him holding "integrity" consistent faith
 - b. She didn't understand curse God and die
 - 2. Job's Wife is rebuked (10)
 - a. Job scolds here for speaking like a foolish woman
 - b. Job did not sin with his lips
