

The Support of Friends (Job 2:11-13)

I. Job's Friends come to comfort him (11-12a)

- A. His friends came from their countries
- B. His friends came to sympathize and comfort him
- C. His friends didn't recognize Job in his sufferings
 - 1. Job was disfigured
 - 2. Job was suffering

II. Job's Friends Mourned for Him (12b)

- A. They raise their voices and wept
- B. They tore their robes
- C. They threw dust over their heads
 - 1. all signs of Hebrew mourning practices

III. Job's Friends Empathize with Him (13)

- A. They sat with him 7 days and nights
- B. They said nothing to him
- C. They saw that his pain was great
