- I. The Need for Laborers (1-2a)
 - A. Jesus sent men to Prepare His way (1)
 - 1. He sent them two by two
 - i. They encourage one another
 - ii. They protect one another
 - iii. They are accountable to one another
 - 2. He sent them into every town before He went
 - i. The preacher prepares the way
 - ii. The gospel prepares the heart
 - iii. Men must preach the Law to prepare the heart
 - iv. Tilled soil is good soil
 - B. Jesus' Workers are desperately needed (2a)
 - 1. The harvest is plentiful
 - i. There are lost people everywhere
 - ii. There are people who will receive the gospel
 - iii. God will accomplish His purpose
 - iv. God will bring his people in
 - 2. The Laborers are few
 - i. People want their own lives
 - ii. People want comfort and ease
 - iii. People work only for their own gain
 - iv. Difference between worker and laborer
 - a. Worker quits when he receives his wage
 - b. Laborer works until the work is done
 - C. Jesus Uses Means to Win Souls
 - 1. All people are called to labor in the field
 - 2. All people are called to harvest in their sphere
 - 3. All people are called to serve Christ
