## Rejoicing in the True Power of God (Luke 10:17-20)

- I. The Laborers return Rejoicing (17)
  - A. They returned from their mission
    - 1. They were sent to minister and preach
    - 2. They were given power and authority
      - a. To heal
      - b. To cast out Spirits
  - B. They Returned Joyously
    - 1. They rejoiced because of their power
    - 2. Even the demons are subject to us in your name
  - C. They were caught up in their own greatness
    - 1. They took joy in their authority
    - 2. They failed to take joy in Christ's authority
- II. The Laborers Are Taught of True Joy (18-20)
  - A. Jesus acknowledges their authority (18-19)
    - 1. Jesus confirms Satan's Fall (18)
      - a. By the Gospel, Satan's power over man is gone
      - b. He has no control where the gospel frees men
    - 2. Jesus confirms the Laborer's power (19)
      - a. power over scorpions and serpents
      - b. power over the enemy
      - c. power to overcome anything
  - B. Jesus Instructs on True Joy (20)
    - 1. Do not rejoice because of your power
    - 2. Do not rejoice because of your authority
    - 3. Rejoice because your names are written in heaven
      - a. True Joy comes from our salvation
      - b. True Joy comes from our Relationship
      - c. True Joy comes from our assurance
