Instructions for Christ's Laborer (Luke 2b-7)

I. Pray (2b)

- A. Everything must begin with prayer
 - 1. You may plant and water but God gives increase 1 Co. 3:6
 - 2. God alone calls men to Labor
 - a. Man cannot labor unless he is called. John 15:16
 - b. His heart must be changed
 - 3. Man cannot Labor without the power of God
 - a. In his own strength, man can do nothing John 15:5
 - b. In Christ's strength he can do all things. Phil. 4:13

II. Go (3)

- A. "Go your Way"
 - 1. Not necessarily leave your family and go to the jungle.

Luke 8:38-39 – "go home and proclaim"

- 2. God has placed each laborer in different fields
 - a. Salt of the earth Scattered among all fields
 - i. Electrician, teacher, plumber, preacher, mother
- 3. The Laborer must determinately go
 - a. He is a fisher of men Matt. 4:19
 - i. The fisherman must go to the fish
 - ii. The fish won't come to him
 - iii. The fisherman must be intentional and opportunistic

III. Trust (4a)

- A. Depend on God to Provide For the Laborer
 - 1. Jesus was teaching them a specific lesson
 - a. God will miraculously provide for you
 - 2. Does not necessarily mean we should not prepare
 - a. Later Jesus told disciples to make sure they had a moneybag and knapsack Luke 22:36
 - 3. It means that everything involved will be from God
 - d. He will provide for His Laborers

IV. Focus (4b)

- A. Greet no one on the road
 - 1. Does not mean don't be friendly
 - 2. In ancient near east formal greetings could take hours
 - a. Involved sharing food and water etc.
- B. Do not let anything distract from the mission
 - 1. traditions, extra clothes, nice things to eat, material

V. Preach (5-6)

- A. Say, "Peace to this house"
 - 1. Proclaim the peace of God Rom. 5:1
 - a. The gospel is the only peace we have with God
 - b. Don't sugarcoat or change the message
 - 2. "Son of Peace" If someone is there who accepts the gospel by faith
 - a. the peace will rest on him

- b. He will find peace with God
- c. He will find rest for his soul Matt. 11:28
- 3. If there is no Son of peace, they will have no peace a. "it will return to you"

VI. Hurry (7)

- A. Do not waste the time you have
 - 1. Remain in the house that receives you
 - a. allow them to provide for you
 - 2. Do not go from house to house
- B. Moving around in this way would be wasting time
 - 1. Establish a base of operations
 - 2. Go out from there
- C. We have ours
 - 1. Go where God has put you
 - 2. Don't waste time looking for the right opportunity
 - 3. Every moment is an opportunity
