- I. Proclaim the Kingdom to Those who Accept You (8-9)
 - A. When a Town Receives You (8a)
 - 1. There is a remnant that will come
 - 2. God will save His people
 - B. Minister the Gospel of the Kingdom (8b-9)
 - 1. Allow them to Provide for you
 - 2. Attend to their physical Needs
 - 3. Preach the Kingdom of God
 - a. The King has come to save his people
 - b. He reigns in the hearts of His people
- II. Proclaim the Kingdom to Those Who Reject You (10-12)
 - A. When a Town Does Not Receive You (10a)
 - 1. Hell enlarging itself every day
 - 2. Gospel is foolishness to those who don't believe
 - 3. We are responsible for obedience not success
 - B. Proclaim the Judgment of the Gospel (10-11)
 - 1. Proclaim their Uncleaness
 - a. Go into the streets
 - b. Wipe the dust from your feet
 - c. Sign of the Jews, defile their land
 - 2. Proclaim the Kingdom of God
 - a. The Kingdom of God has come near
 - b. The Kingdom is the Kingdom whether you reject it or accept
 - c. Jesus is still Lord
 - d. Every knee will bow one way or another
 - C. Their Rejection Will Testify Against Them (12)
 - 1. More bearable for Sodom than for that town
 - a. They had the revelation
 - b. They refused
