Religion Vs. Regeneration (Luke 11:24-26)

- I. Reformation without Regeneration is Useless (24-25)
 - A. An unclean spirit leaves a man and seeks a home (24)
 - 1. This is the reformation of character and behavior
 - a. Man casts out the evil outward behaviors
 - b. Man reforms his life
 - c. Man rededicates himself to do good
 - 2. The demon leaves and travels through dry places
 - a. dry = desserted, without men to inhabit
 - B. The Spirit returns to a clean, swept house
 - 1. The man has reformed and cleaned his house
 - a. however, no one inhabits the house
 - b. there is no one to stop the demon
 - c. The house is put in order for the demon's return
- II. Reformation can Only Bring Religion (26)
 - A. The spirit brings seven others to dwell there
 - 1. these demons are more powerful religious spirits
 - a. They deceive the man into thinking he is good
 - b. they dwell there in a newly reformed man
 - 2. The last state of the man is worse than the first
 - a. At first the man knew he was sinful and unclean
 - b. At the last, he believes he is religious and clean
 - c. The holy spirit does not live in him
 - d. He believes the reformation of his character is what God requires.
