Rejecting God's Revelation (Luke 11:29-32)

- I. The Jews Seek a Greater Revelation (29-30)
 - A. An evil generation seeks a sign (29)
 - 1. So many people reject what God has said and seek a sign to confirm what they want to believe
 - 2. This is the opposite of faith, it is idolatry
 - 3. They find signs in everything they see
 - 4. They want a God that believes like they do.
 - B. The Preaching and Resurrection is the only Sign (29b-30)
 - 1. Only the sign of Jonah will be given (29b)
 - a. The sign of Jonah
 - i. Three days in the belly of the whale and returned
 - a. This corresponds to Jesus' three days in the grave
 - ii. The preaching of Jonah was given to Ninevah
 - a. This corresponds to Jesus' preaching
 - 2. The resurrection and the gospel are the sign
 - a. Man must hear the word and trust the atonement
 - i. no other sign will be given
 - ii. Recall the story of Lazarus in hell
 - a. they have moses and the prophets
- II. The Jews Rejected the Greatest Revelation (31-32)
 - A. The Pagan gueen of Sheba responded to God's revelation
 - 1. She came to hear the wisdom of Solomon
 - a. She will judge God's people (31)
 - 1. She had more reason to reject revelation than Jews
 - 2. She had less revelation than any of God's people
 - 3. She believed the light she had
 - 2. The Jews Rejected Jesus who was greater than Solomon
 - a. They had more revelation than any other
 - b. They rejected Jesus when he came in authority
 - B. The Pagan Nation of Ninevah Responded to God's Revelation (32)
 - 1. Ninevah repented at the preaching of Jonah
 - a. Ninevah will judge God's people
 - 1. They had no reason to respond
 - 2. Jonah was their only revelation
 - 3. They believed the light they had
 - 2. The Jews Rejected Jesus who was greater than Jonah
 - a. They had more revelation than Ninevah
 - b. they rejected Jesus when he came in authority
- III. Today we have the greatest Revelation
 - A. We have Christ and his mission completed
 - b. We have the preaching of Christ and the Apostles
 - C. We have the completed Word of God
