## Take Care How You Live (Luke 12:1-7)

- I. God Sees Our Inner-Most Lives (1-3)
  - A. Beware of Hypocrisy (1)
    - 1. Thousands of people came to Christ
    - 2. Jesus spoke to his disciples
    - 3. Jesus warned them of the Hypocrisy of the Pharisees
      - a. He called it "leven" which infects what it touches
      - b. Be continually on watch in yourselves
  - B. Beware of Thinking Some Things are Hidden (2-3)
    - 1. Everything will eventually become known (2)
      - a. There is Nothing that is covered will not be revealed
      - b. There is nothing hidden that will know be made known
        - i. God is aware of every dark corner of the heart
        - ii. Eventually all will be aware of the heart
        - iii. We must continually be watching for hypocrisy
    - 2. Every Word Spoken in Secret will be Revealed (3)
      - a. Whatever is said in the dark will be brought into light
      - b. Whatever is whispered in private will be made know
  - C. Beware of thinking the small things don't matter
    - 1. Everything, Everything will be revealed and made known
    - 2. God sees and knows everything in the hearts of men
- II. God Cares About Our Inner-Most Lives (4-7)
  - A. God Alone Is To Be Feared (4-5)
    - 1. Do not Fear men (4)
      - a. Believers must strive to please God not men
      - b. Believers have nothing to fear from men
      - c. Believer's bodies can only be affected by men
        - i. After killing the body, men can do nothing more
      - d. To be killed by men is a blessing for the believer
      - e. To be persecuted by men is a blessing for the believer
    - II. Fear God (5)
      - a. Believers must strive to please God
      - b. God can not only kill the body, but resign the soul to hell
      - c. Believers should stucture their innermost lives around the God who sees and knows all
  - B. God Cares About the Intimate Details of Our Lives
    - I. God concerns Himself with the smallest details (6-7)
      - a. God has not forgotten the meager sparrows of creation
      - b. God knows every hair of your head
    - II. God cares more for you than sparrows (7)
      - a. You are of more worth than sparrows
      - b. If God concerns himself with the smallest details so should
    - III. God cares about the good and the bad
      - a. We think of sins in categories of smaller and greater

- b. God is concerned about the smallest of sins
- c. God is concerned with the smallest of pains
- d. God is concerned with every hair of our head.
- IV. We must take care of the smallest details in how we live
  - A. We must care if God does
  - B. We must strive in the fear of Him
  - C. We must Take care how we live.
