## The Fool and His Money (Luke 12:13-21)

- I. Earthly Riches Profit Nothing (13-15)
  - A. Jesus shows that Earthly Treasures are Meaningless (13-14)
    - 1. Jesus is asked to judge an inheritance dispute (13)
      - a. Evidently he had not been listening
      - b. Christ had been talking about God, our lives, and eternal
      - c. All he could think about was his money
    - 2. Jesus dismisses the request (14)
      - a. "Who made me judge over you?"
      - b. Why are you asking these kind of questions
      - c. Who really cares about your earthly treasures
  - B. Jesus Warns against Coveting Treasures (15)
    - 1. Beware of covetousness
      - a. Lit. Watch yourselves / Guard yourselves against
    - 2. Possessions Can't Give Life
      - a. They cannot make life better
      - b. They cannot extend life
      - c. They cannot add anything to eternity
- II. Eternal Riches Profit Everything (16-21)
  - A. Laying Up Treasures in Earth is Pointless (16-20)
    - 1. A man invested his life in riches (16-19)
      - a. He had more than he could ever spend (16-17)
        - i. His land had produced Greatly (16)
          - Notice that it was the land that brought it
          - God had to send rain etc.
          - no indication of thankfulness on his part
      - b. He had more than he could store (17)
        - i. He had been blessed with overabundance
          - he gave no thought to charity
          - he gave no thought to tithing
          - his only thoughts were selfish
    - 2. A man put All his energy toward his riches (18-19)
      - a. He tore down old barns to build new ones
        - i. keeping his riches was hard work
        - ii. his life was consumed with the upkeep
        - iii. he planned everything for his own comfort
      - b. He prepared himself for a life of luxury
        - i. he said to himself, you have everything you need
        - ii. Relax, eat, drink, and be merry
  - B. Earthly Treasures Mean nothing In Death (20)
    - 1. The man's life ended that very night
      - a. God called him a fool
      - b. He prepared nothing except earthly things
        - i. God requires the life of every man
        - ii. Everyone will give an account

- 2. The man's riches were given to another
  - a. Everything he worked for is given away b. He will never enjoy it
- III. Eternal Riches are Riches in God
  - A. The one who stores treasure in heaven in rich
  - B. Storing riches on earth provides nothing
  - C. What has God given you to give away?
