## Worry and the Ultimate Treasure (Luke 12:22-34)

- I. God' People are not to Worry about Life (22-23)
  - A. Do not worry about your earthly needs (22)
    - 1. about your life what you will eat
    - 2. about your body what you will wear
  - B. Life itself is more than earthly needs (23)
    - 1. food and clothes (basic necessities) do not bring life
    - 2. Simply having them does not guarantee provision
    - 3. Simply having them does not guarantee life
- II. Worry is Useless for God's People (24-26)
  - A. God Values His Children more than ravens (24)
    - 1. God meets the daily needs of the ravens
      - a. Ravens don't worry or plan
      - b. Ravens are fed by God
    - 2. God values His people more than ravens
      - a. Will he not meet our daily needs?
      - b. Will he not provide for us as he does those?
  - B. Worrying about Needs is Useless (25-26)
    - 1. Worry cannot add a single hour to your life (25)
    - 2. Worry cannot provide for a single need (26)
- III. Worry is Sinful for God's People (27-30)
  - A. God values His Children More than Lillies (27-28)
    - 1. God provides for the Lillies (27)
      - a. Lillies needs are met without toil or labor
      - b. Lillies are abundantly provided for
        - i. Even Solomon didn't have greater glory
    - 2. God values His people more than Lillies (28)
      - a. The grass is inconsequential
        - i. The grass is here today, gone tomorrow
        - ii. The grass is tossed into the oven for fuel
      - b. God's people are of much more value
  - B. Worrying about Needs is Sinful (29-30)
    - 1. Do not live in worry as the Godless do. (29)
      - a. Don't worry about your needs
      - b. Every heathen worries about his needs (30)
- IV. Seek the Treasure of the Kingdom (31-34)
  - A. Those in God's Kingdom live in His provision (31-32)
    - 1. Seek his kingdom and he will provide (31)
    - 2. Do not fear, he wants to provide(32)
      - a. The King watches over his subjects
      - b. The King makes sure they have provision and protection
      - c. The King governs the Kingdom
  - B. Make God's Kingdom Your heart's treasure (33-34)

- 1. Desire the riches of God (33)
- a. Give away your earthly riches
  b. Receive your heavenly riches
  2. Your heart will follow your treasure (34)
