The Responsibility of Being Prepared (Luke 12:35-48)

- I. The Servant Must be Prepared for the Master's Coming (35-38)
 - A. The Obedient Servant is Prepared (35-36)
 - 1. He must be ready for action
 - a. He must be prepared in mind, life, and heart
 - b. Gird his loins prepared to go
 - i. Israel did this before running into war
 - 2. He must keep His lamp burning
 - a. He must be expecting the master's coming
 - b. He must keep the light on for his return
 - B. The Obedient Servant is Rewarded (37-38)
 - 1. The Master will reward the expectant servant (37)
 - a. The servant will be blessed by the master
 - i. Only the servants found awake
 - ii. These are the servants looking for his coming
 - b. The servant will be served
 - i. He will recline at the table
 - ii. His service will be accomplished
 - 2. The Master will be pleased with the expectant servant (38)
 - a. The Master could come at any time
 - i. He could come in the wee hours when all others sleep
 - b. The master will bless the servant who is awake
- II. The Ministers Must Be Ready For the Master's Coming (39-48)
 - A. The Obedient Minister will be rewarded at his coming (39-44)
 - 1. God's people must be ready for his coming (39-40)
 - a. The thief could come and plunder at any time (39)
 - b. The Son of Man could come at anytime (40)
 - i. you must be ready, just as the protector of the house is
 - 2. The Obedient Minister will be rewarded (42-44)
 - a. The Lord has placed managers over his house
 - b. Blessed are those who manage it accordingly (43)
 - c. The faithful manager will be given greater responsibility (44)
 - B. The Unfaithful Minister will be punished at his coming (45-46)
 - 1. The descriptions of unfaithful ministers (45)
 - a. They take advantage of the household
 - b. They Lord over the household with iron fist
 - c. They plunder the riches for their own pleasure
 - 2. The Punishment of unfaithful ministers (46)
 - a. The master will come unexpectedly
 - b. The master will cut him to pieces
 - c. The master will cast him with the unfaithful
 - C. Every unprepared servant will be punished (47-48)
 - 1. The willfully unprepared will be punished severely (47)
 - 2. The ignorantly unprepared will be punished to a lesser degree (48)
 - 3. Everyone will bear the responsibility of his calling

- a. He will be accountable for what he has been given
- b. He will be responsible for what he has been entrusted with
