- I. Will You Be Saved? (22-24)
  - A. Someone asked, "How many will be saved?" (22-23a)
    - 1. Will it only be a few?
    - 2. They though Jews only and Jesus was saying many Jews wouldn't
  - B. Jesus answered, "Focus on your own life." (23b-24)
    - 1. YOU strive to enter (23b)
      - a. You worry about your ownself not how many others?
      - b. The door is narrow
        - Not many can fit through
        - "few be that find it"
    - 2. Many will not Enter (24)
      - a. Many people will want to enter
      - b. Many will not be able
        - Man wants to work his way there
        - Man wants to earn his goodness
- II. Time is Running Out (25a)
  - A. The door will be shut
    - 1. Man doesn't have forever
    - 2. Man cannot come unless drawn by the Spirit
    - 3. God doesn't owe us anything
  - B. Some will be Left outside
    - 1. They will see their sinfulness when it is too late
- III. Only the Righteous Will Enter (25b-27)
  - A. Familiarity will not suffice (25b-26a)
    - 1. He will not acknowledge them (25b)
    - 2. Although they were acquainted with Him (26a)
      - a. They claimed they fellowshipped with Him
        - ate and drank in their presence
      - b. They claimed to have heard his teachings
        - taught in our streets
  - B. Righteousness Alone will Suffice (27)
    - 1. He will not acknowledge them
    - 2. Workers of Evil must depart
- IV. Suffering and Comfort from Suffering (28-30)
  - A. Being Denied Will Be A Great Torment (28)
    - 1. Those outside will mourn, seeing the saints
      - a. They thought all Jews were in
      - b. They thought they were entitled
      - c. They were proud to be with Abraham, Isaac, Jacob
    - 2. Those outside will not be allowed in
  - B. Being Accepted Will Be A Great Honor (29-30)
    - 1. People from all nations will enter (29)
      - a. This would have offended them
      - b. They thought they were entitled, others not

- c. Jesus said those who "unworthy" would enter 2. The Humble and Contrite will be Exalted
- - a. The Proud cast out
