## The Obstacle of Tradition - Luke 14:1-6

- I. Tradition is Challenged (1-4a)
  - A. Will Jesus Break Tradition to Do His Work? (1-2a)
    - 1. The Pharisees watched Jesus Closely (1)
      - a. Always looking to critique and find fault
      - b. Sabbath Tradition prevented healing
    - 2. A Man Came Before Jesus in Need (2)
      - a. The man had Dropsy
        - swollen limbs, fluid accumulating in legs
    - 3. Two types of People Before Jesus
      - a. One is proud and seeking to find fault
      - b. One is humble, in need of help
  - B. Jesus Challenged The Pharisees Ideas of the Sabbath (3-4a)
    - 1. Jesus asked a simple question (3)
      - a. Is it Lawful to Heal on the Sabbath?
        - Seems like a simple question
        - Tradition says no
        - Pharisees remember the woman He healed
    - 2. The Pharisees Remained Silent
      - a. They could not answer
      - b. They were bound by their tradition
- II. Godliness is Commended (4b-6)
  - A. Jesus Healed the Man on the Sabbath (4b)
    - 1. He took him
    - 2. He healed him
    - 3. He sent Him away
  - B. Jesus demonstrated the Pharisees' Hypocrisy (5-6)
    - 1. He showed them how they broke the Sabbath
      - a. They broke it to benefit themselves
      - b. Their ox or donkey falls in a ditch
    - 2. They could not reply to Him (6)
