- I. The Lack of Humility (7)
 - A. Jesus noticed People Vying For Places of Honor
 - 1. He was at a banquet
 - 2. Seeing people trying to gain respect
 - 3. The closer they sit to host, the greater the honor
 - a. We want honor and respect
 - b. We fight to obtain it
 - c. We feel wronged if we don't get it
- II. The Honor of Humility (8-10)
 - A. The Prideful Are Humbled (8-9)
 - 1. Do not think more of yourself than you are
 - a. Jesus said, "Don't sit in place of honor"
 - b. Someone more honorable may come in
 - 2. You will be shamed to take your true position
 - a. How embarrassing it would be to be moved down
 - b. Everyone will know your pride
 - B. The Humble Are Exalted (10)
 - 1. Presume Yourself Lowly in Humility
 - a. Go and sit in the lowest place
 - b. Not Ashamed, but humble
 - 2. You will Be Honored to take your true position
 - a. All will hear the host say, "move up"
 - b. Your humility results in honor
- III. The Reward of Humility (11)
 - A. Everyone who exalts himself will be humbled
 - B. Everyone who humbles himself will be exalted
 - 1. Let the Lord exalt you
 - 2. Don't try to exalt yourself
