 - a. Rich man employed him to manage
 - b. Rich man heard he squandered his money

 - 3. The boss fires the manager (2b)
 - B. The dishonest manager prepares for his future (3-7)
 - 1. The manager feared being impoverished (3)
 - a. He became afraid
 - b. He was not strong enough to dig
 - c. He was too ashamed to beg
 - 2. The manager begins to plan (4)
 - a. He know he will be removed
 - b. He plans so that people will care for him
 - 3. The manager gains friends through deceit (5-7)
 - a. He called in his master's debtors(5)
 - b. He changed the amount they owed(6-7)

 - a. "called unrighteous manager"

 - A. Managing Eternal Resources (9-12)
 - 1. Use your resources to make eternal friends (9)
 - a. Jesus teaches from the Parable
 - you are going to need eternal friends (God, converts)
 - use what you have been given (worldly wealth)
 - Worldly wealth will eventually fail
 - You will need an eternal dwelling
 - 2. The smallest Resources Have Eternal Consequences (10)
 - a. Faithful in a little = faithful in much
 - b. Unrighteous in a little = unrighteous in much
 - parable of talents
 - use what you have been given
 - 3. The unfaithful with earthly won't be given heavenly
 - a. If you can't even be faithful with unrighteous wealth
 - b. Who will give you true riches?
 - 4. The unfaithful with other's won't be given his own
 - a. We all take good care of our own stuff
 - b. Not so much other people's
