## Lazarus And The Rich Man – Luke 16:19-31

Jesus showed the folly of not preparing for eternity, and that the gospel alone can save man from his sin. Now He shows how it works.

- I. Lazarus and The Rich Man Enter Eternity (19-23)
  - A. A Rich and Poor Man Die (19-22)
    - 1. The rich and Lazarus lived near each other (19-21)
      - a. The rich man lived in luxury (19)
        - clothed in purple and fine linen
        - feasted sumptuously every day
        - living the life, no cares
      - b. Lazarus lived in squalor (20-21)
        - at the rich man's gate
        - covered with sores
        - desired scraps from the table
        - eating the rich man's garbage
        - lower than dogs licked his sores
    - 2. The rich man and Lazarus die (22-23)
      - a. Lazarus Went to Paradise (Abraham's Bosom)
        - He was carried there by angels
        - By Abraham's Side (all good Jews wanted to be)
        - Sounds so lovely
      - b. Rich man Went to Hades
        - He was buried (not so lovely sounding)
        - went to torment in hades
- II. The Rich Man is Too Late (24-31)
  - A. Abraham Could Not Relieve the Rich Man (24-26)
    - 1. The Rich Man Cries For Relief (24)
      - a. He Was Depending on Religion / Lineage
        - "Father Abraham..."
      - b. He wanted Relief
        - No repentance, no remorse
        - Just get me some ease
    - 2. Religion Could Not Relieve Him (25-26)
      - a. Abraham Reminded Him of His Life (25a)
        - He called him "child" good Jew
        - He reminded him of his good life
        - He reminded him of Lazarus' torment in life
      - b. Abraham Explained His Condition (25b)
        - Now Lazarus is comforted
        - Now He is in Anguish
      - c. Abraham Explained His Situation (26)
        - Even if Abraham wanted to He couldn't
        - A great chasm kept them apart
        - No one may cross

## d. Religion was Useless

- B. Abraham Could Not Report On The Rich Man's Condition
  - 1. Men Have God's Warning (27-29)
    - a. The Rich man Wants His Brother's warned
      - send Him to my father's house
      - So they won't come here
    - b. No other warning but Scripture will be given (29)
      - They have Moses and Prophets
      - The OT Scriptures Testified of Gospel
  - 2. God Has Sufficiently Warned Man (30-31)
    - a. The Rich man Cries For Proof (30)
      - My brothers need proof
      - Someone rising from the dead
      - they will repent
    - b. Scripture is Sufficient Proof (31)
      - If they won't receive Scripture
      - They won't be convinced by anything
