- A. Servants don't Earn Rights From Serving (7-9)
 - 1. Servants Don't become family by doing their duty (7)
 - a. To Eat at Table meant close connection of fellowship
 - b. Like a waitress sitting down to eat with family
 - c. Masters Don't owe Servants for Serving
 - 2. Servants Are Expected To Do their Duty (8)
 - a. Even after works in the field, expected to serve
 - b. Prepare the food, dress properly, serve the Master the meal
 - c. Only after His duty is complete will he eat and drink
 - 3. Servants Are Not Praised For Doing their Duty (9)
 - a. Thanks are not necessary for servant obeying master
 - b. Duty of the Servant to Obey Master
- B. God's Servants Don't Earn Rights From Serving (10)
 - 1. Doing What is Commanded Doesn't Earn anything
 - 2. Doing What is Commanded is Our Duty Anyway
 - 3. Doing What is Commanded is Owed to God Even Without Reward
 - 4. God's Servants Are All Unworthy of Blessing and Honor
- II. Few Servants Give God Proper Obeisance (11-19)
 - A. 10 Lepers Receive the Blessing of Healing (11-14)
 - 1. 10 Lepers Cry Out For Mercy (11-13)
 - a. A Desolate Region
 - b. Lepers Were Outcasts From Society
 - c. Lepers Were Not Allowed to Approach (Unclean, unclean)
 - d. Lepers Were Not Allowed in the Temple
 - Lepers recognized their position cried out to Jesus
 - We do same when we are in a jam
 - 2. Jesus Cleanses Lepers As they Go to Priest (14)
 - a. Show Yourselves to the Priest OT Law, declared clean (8

days)

- b. They obeyed before they saw miracle
- c. On they way they were cleansed
- B. One Leper Returns To Praise God (15-19)
 - 1. One Leper Returned to Jesus (15-18)
 - a. Only One Samaritan Returned with Praise and Thanks (15-

16)

- b. Turned back, loud voice, fell on his face
- 2. Nine out of ten did not return (17-18)
 - a. They had their blessing, forgot God and Jesus
 - b. People are easily satisfied and complacent
- C. The One Leper is Saved by Faith (19)
 - 1. "well" = delivered, saved
 - 2. Faith in Christ delivered His soul
 - 3. He wanted relationship with the man, not just benefits.
