- I. The Testimony of The Christ (Luke 2:21-38)
  - A. Christ's Birth Bore Witness to the Law (21-24)
    - 1. He Was Christened According to the Law (21)
      - a. Christ was circumcised on the 8th day (Gen. 17)
      - b. Christ was named Jesus according to God's Word (Luke 1:31)
    - 2. He Was Presented According to the Law (22-24)
      - a. Christ was dedicated to the Lord according to the Law (22-23)
        - 40 days Old
        - According to Leviticus 12
      - b. Christ was "redeemed" according to the Law (24)
        - His parents offered sacrifices
        - According to Exodus 12:1-8
        - They were too poor to offer a lamb
    - 3. He Was Born Under the Law and Fulfilled It
      - a. Christ fulfilled every part of God's Law
      - b. Christ's birth, life, and death fulfilled the Law
  - B. The Spirit Bore Witness To the Christ (25-38)
    - 1. The Spirit Revealed Christ To Simeon (25-35)
      - a. Simeon was righteous and devout (25)
      - b. The Holy Spirit was Upon him
    - 2. Simeon Testified to the Christ (26-35)
      - a. Simeon Glorified God For Jesus (26-32)
        - i. He rejoiced at the Fulfillment of God's Word (26-28)
          - God told him he would see the Messiah (26)
          - He blessed (thanked) God when He saw Him (27-28)
      - b. Simeon Glorified God for Salvation (29-32)
        - i. He thanked God for revealing Salvation (29)
        - ii. He praised God for sending it to the whole world (31-32)
          - To Israel
          - To the Gentiles
      - c. Simeon Prophesied Concerning Jesus (33-35)
        - i. Jesus would bring Salvation and Condemnation (34)
        - ii. Jesus would be opposed
        - iii. Jesus' position would cause Mary great sorrow (35)
        - iv. Jesus would reveal men's hearts
          - Jews thought righteous works were enough
          - It didn't matter about their hearts
          - Only the heart reborn is right before God
          - The intent of the law, sermon on the mount, etc. is to reveal the horrible heart of man
    - 3. Anna Testified to the Christ (36-38)
      - a. Anna was an elderly prophetess (36-37)
        - i. God used her to speak His Word
        - ii. Perhaps her testimony of Jesus

- b. Anna was devoted to God (37)
  - i. Remained in the Temple
  - ii. Praying and fasting, day and night
- c. Anna Witnessed the Christ (38)
  - i. "At that very Hour" While Simeon was speaking
  - ii. She thanked God for salvation
- d. Anna Became a Witness For Christ (38)
  - i. She spoke of him to all who were waiting
