- I. Religion Fights Against Conviction (19-22)
 - A. The Religious Refused Jesus' Instruction
 - 1. They conspired against Jesus
 - a. They were angry at His parable
 - b. They knew he was speaking about them
 - c. They were afraid of the crowd
 - 2. They sought to trap him with logic (20)
 - a. They sent in spies
 - b. They wanted to catch him in his words
 - c. They sought to give him to Roman law
 - B. The Religious Sought to Discredit Jesus (21-22)
 - 1. They flattered him
 - a. "speak and teach rightly"
 - b. "show no partiality"
 - c. "truly teach the way of God"
 - D. Religion makes you feel good
 - 2. They tried to trap him with politics
 - a. Taxes were the hot issue of the day
 - b. Jews saw it as reprehensible to God
 - c. Treason not to pay
 - d. They asked, "Does it belong to God or Caesar"
- II. Truth Silences Religion (23-26)
 - A. Jesus Demonstrates Truth (23-25)
 - 1. Jesus showed Caesar's image on the coin
 - 2. Jesus said give Caesar and God their due
 - B. They could not respond (26)
