Jesus Heals the Desperate (Luke 5:17-26)

- I. Both the Religious and Desperate Come to Jesus (17-20)
 - A. Religious Men Come to Jesus (17)
 - 1. Pharisees and teachers of the Law came to hear him
 - 2. God's power was with Him to Heal
 - B. Desperate Men Come to Jesus (18-20)
 - 1. Desperate Men came carrying a paralytic (18)
 - i. They obviously cared for the man
 - ii. They knew Jesus was their only hope
 - 2. Desperate Men Found a Way through (19)
 - i. They had to get through
 - ii. There was no other hope
 - iii. They were desperate in their hopelessness
 - 3. Desperate Men Are healed of their sin (20)
 - i. Jesus saw their faith
 - ii. Jesus healed the man's real problem
 - iii. We want comfort, when Jesus wants reconciliation
- II. The Religious are Shamed and the Desperate Healed (21-27)
 - A. Jesus Scolds the Religious Men (21-23)
 - 1. The Religious refused Jesus' authority (21)
 - i. They believed they were righteous
 - ii. They wanted God to see their works
 - iii. They wanted God to see their religion
 - 2. Jesus Questions the Religious' understanding (22-23)
 - i. They did not believe Jesus could forgive sins
 - ii. They doubted who He was
 - iii. They doubted that sins were forgiven by faith
 - B. Jesus Heals the Desperate Man's Body (24-27)
 - 1. Jesus proves His authority to forgive (24)
 - i. Iesus heals the man's body
 - ii. The people think physical healing is harder
 - 2. God is glorified Through the Desperates healing (25)
 - i. Greatest miracle is salvation
 - ii. God is glorified in salvation more than healing
 - 3. All who saw it glorified God (26)
 - i. Awe and wonder came from healing
 - ii. The true miracle was the salvation
