The Evidence a Person Has been delivered (Luke 6:43-49)

- I. A Person's Fruit is the Evidence of His salvation (43-45)
 - A. Trees are identified by their fruit (43-44a)
 - 1. Good trees don't bear bad fruit
 - 2. Bad trees don't bear good fruit
 - a. Notice the present tense in Greek -
 - b. It speaks of consistently bearing the fruit
 - c. Speaks of a lifestyle of fruit-bearing
 - 2. Each tree is known by the consistency of its fruit
 - B. Trees cannot bear a different species of Fruit (44b)
 - 1. Thornbushes do not produce figs
 - 2. Bramble bushes don't produce grapes
 - a. Fruit can only be produced by species
 - b. The man enslaved to sin can only produce sin
 - i. He may do good things
 - ii. He cannot do righteous things before God
 - C. Man's Heart produces His fruit (45)
 - 1. Good fruit can only be produced from a good heart
 - 2. Evil fruit can only consistently be produced from an evil heart
 - 3. All fruit is produced by the heart.
 - a. The question is not "should I start doing better"
 - b. The question is "what is my heart producing"
 - D. The Heart that is delivered will produce good fruit
- II. Jesus Delivers His Servants (heart change) (46-49)
 - A. Those producing evil fruit are not delivered (46)
 - B. Those producing good fruit have been delivered
 - 1. The fruitful are delivered from judgment (47-48)
 - a. The man who builds only upon Christ (47)
 - i. He trusts alone in Christ
 - ii. Hears and keeps Christ's words
 - b. This man survives the flood (48)
 - i. He builds upon the foundation of Christ
 - ii. The flood is the wrath of God
 - iii. He withstands the storm
 - 2. The unfruitful is destroyed in Judgment (49)
 - a. The man does not build on Christ
 - i. He does not heed christ's words
 - ii. He aspires for his own righteousness
 - b. This man is destroyed
 - i. His ruin is great
