 - A. The Man Worthy of Jesus? (2-5)
 - 1. A Miracle was Needed (2-3)
 - a. A centurions' beloved servant was sick (2)
 - b. The centurion sent elders to ask Jesus for healing (3)
 - 2. A Miracle was Expected (4-5)
 - a. The elders Pleaded earnestly for the centurion (4)
 - b. The elders claimed he was worthy of Jesus' miracle (5)
 - He loves the nation of Israel
 - He built the synagogue in Capernaum
 - He had done many good things for God
 - B. The Man Unworthy of Jesus (6-7a)
 - 1. The centurion sent friends to stop Jesus (6)
 - a. Perhaps he had heard what the elders said
 - b. Perhaps he thought better of his choice of messengers
 - 2. The centurion understood he was unworthy of Jesus (7a)
 - a. Not just unworthy of the miracle
 - b. Unworthy of his presence
- II. A Certain Faith in the Lord (7b-10)
 - A. The Man Trusting In Christ's Authority (7b-8)
 - 1. The Centurion trusted in Jesus' Power (7b)
 - a. "say the word"
 - 2. The Centurion undertood what it meant to command (8)
 - a. He trusted Jesus' authority of sickness
 - b. Jesus need not even come for he has all power
 - c. Just as the commander commands his soldiers
 Jesus commands creation
 - B. The Man is Rewarded (9-10)
 - 1. Jesus marveled at the centurion's faith
 - a. Even the Israelites didn't have this faith
 - 2. Jesus healed the servant
