 - a. John is Dedicated to the Lord (24-25)
 - A. John has Strong Convictions (24)
 - 1. John was not a reed shaken by the wind
 - B. John was not enticed by Worldly things (25)
 - 1. John did not wear kingly robes
 - 2. John wore humble garments
 - 3. John did not live in palaces
 - 4. John would not change his message for comfort
 - b. John is a Prophet foretold in Scripture (26-27)
 - A. Called by God as a Messenger
 - B. Called to Prepare the Lord's way
- II. The Least in the Kingdom is Greater
 - a. He is perfect by Christ's blood
