## Man's Judgment of God's Counsel (Luke 7:29-35)

- I. God's Counsel is offered to man (29-30)
- (They have just heard Jesus proclaim John's greatness and the kingdom OF GOD)
  - A. The Repentant Accept God's Judgments (29)
    - a. "justified God" He is just to Judge, He is right to condemn
    - b. They had been baptized by John baptism of repentance
  - B. The Unrepentant Refuse God's Judgments (30)
    - a. "rejected the counsel of God"
    - b. they were not baptized by John
    - c. Refused repentance and Jesus' instruction
- II. Man Refuses God's Counsel (31-35)
  - A. They Were Like Unsatisfied Children (31-32)
    - 1. Jesus said they were Like children playing in marketplace
      - a. Children would play games based on what they saw
      - b. Two popular games were "wedding" and "funeral"
        - They would pretend to party like at a wedding
          - i. Jewish weddings were week long festivities
        - They would pretend to mourn at funerals
          - i. Jewish funeral processions were very public
        - Out of this a children's taunt arose for those who refused to play anything.
    - 2. They refused to play weddings or funerals (32)
      - a. They refused to dance when the flute was played
      - b. They refused to weep when the dirge was sung
  - B. They Refused The Message Regardless of the Messenger (33-34)
    - 1. They rejected John the Baptist's Condemning Message (33)
      - a. John came commanding repentance
      - b. John condemned the Pharisees and demanded repentance
      - c. John was soft on no sin and exalted God's law
      - d. John came fasting and exalting the Law as the Pharisees did
      - e. They said he was demonic because he condemned them
    - 2. They rejected Jesus' Message of Salvation (34)
      - a. Jesus came eating and drinking with sinners
      - b. Jesus associated with the lowest people even Gentiles
      - c. Jesus and disciples did not fast as the Pharisees did
      - d. They said he was too loose in his keeping of the law.
    - 3. John played "funerals" and Jesus played "weddings" they accepted neither
  - C. This revealed their true nature (35)
    - 1. Wisdom is known by her children

The children who accept neither reveal their nature True wisdom is to understand the message and messenger
