 - A. Jesus was preaching with the twelve (1)
 - 1. good news of the Kingdom of God
 - B. Many Women Were With them Also (2-3)
 - 1. Mary Magdalene
 - 2. Joanna
 - 3. Many others
 - a. Provided for them out of their means
- II. The Parable of The Soils (4-8)
 - A. Jesus preaches in a Parable (4)
 - B. The Seed and the Soils (5-8a)
 - 1. The seed on the path was devoured (5)
 - 2. The seed on the rock withered (6)
 - 3. The seed among thorns was choked (7)
 - 4. The seed on good soil produced fruit (8a)
 - C. Jesus warned to listen with understanding (8b)
 - 1. the one with ears, let him hear
- III The Secrets of the Kingdom (9-10)
 - A. Only Those of Faith Hear the Word
 - 1. The Secrets of the Kingdom are only for the disciples (9)
 - 2. Jesus spoke to others in parables (10)
 - a. Seeing they may not see
 - b. Hearing they may not understand
- IV. The Parable Explained (11-15)
 - A. The Seed is the Word of God (11)
 - 1. Specifically the gospel of Christ
 - 2. More generally, any word of God
 - B. The Path is those who Reject the Gospel (12)
 - 1. They hear, the devil takes away the word
 - 2. They are not saved
 - 3. Paths of 1st century were packed hard
 - C. The Rocks "believe" until Testing
 - 1. Hear and receive the word "with joy"
 - 2. They have no root
 - 3. They believe for a while then fall away
 - D. The Thorns are choked by worldly cares (14)
 - 1. They hear
 - 2. Cares, Riches, Pleasures choke the word
 - 3. They do not produce fruit
 - E. The good soil Believes and produces fruit (15)
 - 1. Hear and hold fast to the word
 - 2. an honest and good heart
 - 3. Bear fruit with endurance
