 - A. Jesus Confronts A Demonized Man (26-29)
 - 1. A Demonized Man Meets Jesus (26-27)
 - a. The man was naked (27)
 - b. The man lived among tombs
 - c. The man was violent (Matt 8:28) Fierce –no on could pass
 - 2. The Demons Recognized Jesus (28-29a)
 - a. Recognized Jesus' Power (28)
 - i. Bowed before Him
 - b. Recognized Jesus' Identity
 - ii. "Son of the Most High God"
 - c. Recognized Jesus' Authority (28c-29a)
 - iii. Do not torment me
 - iv. Jesus commanded them
 - v. They obeyed
 - B. The Demonized Man Was Beyond Help (29)
 - 1. The Demon often Seized Him
 - a. Men could only keep guard over him
 - b. Men could only bind him with chains
 - c. He would break the chains and be driven into wilderness
 - C. Jesus Commands the Demon (30-33)
 - 1. The Demon reveals His name (30)
 - a. Jesus asks and the demon answers
 - b. Legion there were many demons
 - 2. The Demons beg for their existence (31-32)
 - a. "Don't send us into the abvss"
 - b. They knew their final end
 - 3. The Demons are sent into a Herd of Pigs (33)
 - a. The demons caused the pigs to drown themselves
 - b. (Lev 11:7) prohibits hog farming
 - c. The pigs demonstrated the divine power of Jesus
 - d. Can't see spirits, but everyone saw what they did to the pigs
- II. Man's Reaction to Jesus' Power (34-39)
 - A. People Feared and Wanted Jesus gone (34-37a)
 - 1. The herdsman saw Jesus work in the man and were afraid
 - a. Afraid of losing profits (pigs)
 - b. Afraid of Jesus changing them
 - i. Clothed and in his right mind
 - ii. People don't want Jesus to change them
 - 2. The fearful people asked Jesus to leave (36-37a)
 - a. Their great fear seized them
 - b. They were afraid of Jesus
 - B. The Healed Man Desired to Follow Christ (37b-39)
 - 1. He begged Christ to go with him (37b-38a)
