God Alone Gives Provision and Opportunity for Ministry (Luke 9:10-17)

- I. The On-going Life of Ministry (10-13a)
 - A. Jesus took every opportunity to minister (10-11)
 - 1. Jesus and the disciples were withdrawing after their first mission (10)
 - a. They were probably extremely tired
 - b. They were anxious for fellowship and rest
 - c. They were ready to tell each other of their journeys
 - 2. Jesus took the opportunity to minister to the crowd (11)
 - a. "welcomed them" although tired
 - b. Preached to them
 - c. Ministered to their needs (healed them)
 - B. Jesus Gave the Disciples the opportunity to Minister (12)
 - 1. The disciples desired to have the crowd sent home
 - a. "get provisions" disciples were probably hungry too
 - b. They wanted Jesus to themselves
 - c. They had been the ones working for Him
 - d. They were in a "desolate place"
 - 2. Jesus tests their faith and resolve (13a)
 - a. "You feed them"
 - b. They had just returned in the power of God
 - c. They had healed and cast out demons
 - d. They had seen God's hand at work
 - e. Yet, they would not trust God for provision
 - i. They were still thinking worldly logistics.
