## The Truth about Jesus (Luke 9:18-22)

- I. Men Have Many Opinions of Jesus (18-19)
  - A. Jesus asks who the crowd thinks He is (18)
    - 1. This is the question that matters most
    - 2. "Experience" matters little
    - 3. "I prayed and Jesus helped me"
  - B. The Crowd had Many Opinions (19)
    - 1. The crowd had seen the miracles
    - 2. They ate the loaves and fishes
    - 3. It was undeniable
      - a. Today, it is the same thing
      - b. Glory of Creation shows him
      - c. Law written on hearts
      - d. Lives changed
- II. Men Must Acknowledge Jesus As Christ (20)
  - A. Jesus makes the question personal
    - a. What do "you" say?
    - b. Majority doesn't rule
    - c. Stand alone at judgment
  - B. Peter answers correctly
    - a. "The Messiah of God"
    - b. OT Revelation God and Man
    - c. The one in Isa. 53
- III. Men Must Acknowledge the Work of Christ (21-22)
  - A. Jesus Forbade the disciples from revealing his identity (21)
    - a. Why would he do this?
    - b. Without Faith in His Work His deity is not the gospel
      - i. Jesus had not yet gone to the cross
      - ii. Jesus had not yet finished his work
      - iii. Iesus was not the overlord Messiah they wanted
      - iv. Jesus and the Gospel must be proclaimed
  - B. Jesus Had Not Yet Completed His Mission (21-22)
    - a. For Salvation, Christ must suffer and die
      - i. Must be rejected
      - ii. Must be killed
    - b. For Salvation, Christ must be raised from the dead
      - i. This is the Gospel
      - ii. Running around saying "Jesus" does little without the cross
