Who Is The Greatest? (Luke 9:46-50)

- I. The Disciples Argue About Their Greatness (46)
 - A. Seems Kind of strange after Jesus' humbling of them
 - 1. The disciples still thought the earthly kingdom was coming
 - 2. They were vying for position
 - 3. We do the same
 - 4. Instead of finding our worth in Him alone, we try to earn it
- II. The Disciples Learn that Humble Service Defines Greatness (47-50)
 - A. Jesus Gives them a lesson on Greatness (47-48)
 - 1. The Greatest are Those who Love the Lowly (47-48a)
 - a. Jesus, knowing their hearts, showed them a child (47-48a)
 - b. Jesus showed them that greatness involves receiving the child
 - Very uncommon for great Rabbi's and Leaders to
 - receive children
 - Greatness involves reconciling people to God
 - The lowest people on the social ladder
 - 2. The Greatest Are The Least (48b)
- III. The Disciples Learn that Service if Greater than the Servant (49-50)
 - A. The Disciples Sought Position Instead of Mission (49)
 - 1. John had seen others ministering in Jesus' name
 - 2. John tried to stop them from ministering
 - a. They wanted the position of being in the new Kingdom
 - b. They weren't concerned about the ministry but their role
 - B. The Disciples are Warned to Value Mission Over Position (50)
 - 1. Jesus commands them not to hinder others
 - 2. Those who are not against the mission are for it.
 - C. Greatness has to do with the Mission not Position
 - 1. The Disciples are only great when they are humble
 - 2. They are only great when they are on mission
