The Terms of The Disciple (Luke 9:51-62)

- I. Jesus is Rejected in Samaria (51-56)
 - A. Jesus is Rejected Due to Religion (51-53)
 - 1. Jesus was determined to finish His Work (51)
 - a. "Set his face toward Jerusalem"
 - 2. Jesus is Rejected by Samaritan Village (52-53)
 - a. Samaritans hated Iews
 - b. They worshiped in the mountain of Gersham
 - c. Jesus was going to Jerusalem
 - d. Their religion wouldn't allow them to accept him
 - B. Jesus' Rejection is Met With Mercy Instead of Judgment (54-56)
 - 1. James and John wanted to call down Judgment (54)
 - a. They were thinking of OT Kingdoms and judgments
 - b. They were on their way to Jerusalem to take over
 - c. Why shouldn't judgment start now
 - d. They still didn't understand His mission
 - 2. Jesus Rebuked them and they moved on (55-56)
 - a. It was not time for Judgment
 - b. Jesus' mission was to bring mercy
 - C. Jesus' Disciples must follow His ways and His paths
 - 1. They don't call down judgment on those who reject
 - 2. They speak and act with mercy
 - 3. They understand the gospel call
- II. Jesus' Demands of Those Who Follow (57-62)
 - A. Jesus calls his followers to leave worldliness (57-58)
 - 1. A man announces his desire to follow Jesus (57)
 - a. This man probably thought he was following a new king
 - b. This man thought Jesus was taking over the kingdom
 - c. This man wanted a life of luxury and reward for choosing
 - 2. Jesus informs the man that he is following him into humility
 - a. Jesus tells him that he has no where to live
 - b. Jesus calls him to a humility lower than the animals
 - i. Even the foxes have holes
 - ii. Even the birds have nests
 - iii. The son of man has nothing to luxury to offer
 - B. Jesus calls his followers not to hesitate (59-60)
 - 1. A man asks for some time before following (59)
 - a. He asks to go and bury his father
 - i. Father not necessarily dead
 - ii. Custom to meet needs in declining years
 - iii. Be around to claim inheritance
 - iv. He wanted to insure his security before following
 - 2. Jesus demands his followers not hesitate (60)
 - a. Only disciples can spread the kingdom
 - b. Non-believers can take care of other concerns

- c. The spiritually dead can bury the physically dead
- d. The call of Christ take precedence over all other things
- C. Jesus calls his followers to remain focused (61-62)
 - 1. A man asks for a short period of time to say goodbye
 - a. The man wanted to get his house in order
 - b. He wanted to tell his household goodbye
 - c. Yet the mission must take precedent
 - 2. Jesus calls the follower to not look back to the things behind (62)
 - a. No one who looks back is fit (worthy) of the kingdom
 - b. The calling is to plow and harvest
 - c. Once the hand is put to the plow, the plowman must watch
 - d. Looking back will cause uneven rows and poor crop.
