- I. Introduction (1-2)
 - A. Servants of Christ
 - 1. Slaves...ruled over
 - 2. Ministers...work for Him
 - B. To the Saints
 - 1. Made perfect in Christ
 - 2. Those who lead them (elders, deacons)
- II. Thankful For God's Work In Them (3-7)
 - A. The Philippians were Steadfast
 - 1. He prays with joy for them
 - a. They helped with the gospel
 - i. From the first day until now = steadfast
 - ii. God did this in them
 - b. They are being perfected
 - i. God is still working in them
 - B. The Philippians were Servant Workers
 - 1. He holds them in his heart
 - a. They helped in his imprisonment
 - b. they helped in defense of the gospel
 - c. They helped in the confirmation of the gospel
 - 2. He Considers them partakers in Grace
 - a. They understand that works don't merit
 - b. They are working from grace not for it
- III. Thankful For God's Continuing Work in Them (8-11)
 - A. Paul Desires Their Growth
 - 1. He wants their love to grow
 - a. love grows in knowledge
 - b. love grows in discernment
 - i. Examine / to approve
 - 2. He wants their love to be outwardly manifest
 - B. Paul Desires their Exaltation
 - 1. Christ's Work in them Works
 - a. They Test what is good
 - i. This is proof of their standing
 - ii. sincere and blameless on the day of Christ
 - iii. having been filled with evidence of righteousness
 - b. This only Comes through Jesus
 - c. This is only expressed for God's glory
