- I. Conduct Yourself Worthy of The Gospel (27-28)
 - A. Live Consistent with Your Profession (27)
 - 1. "Only" (Monon) = No matter what (most important)
 - a. Regardless if Paul gets out or not
 - b. Regardless if Paul comes to them or not
 - 2. Live Before Christ Not other men
 - B. Live consistent with the Gospel Itself
 - 1. Standing Firm in on Spirit (together)
 - a. Having a Singular Mind
 - i. Same goals, same purpose
 - ii. Same belief, same confidence
 - b. Contending For the Faith of the Gospel
 - i. refusing to accept heresy
 - ii. Fighting for faith in own life
 - war on sin
 - war on worldliness
 - c. Standing together in Church Fellowship
 - i. συναθλουντες striving side by side
 - not a lone soldier
 - not even fighting sin alone
 - C. Live Fearlessly Before Opponents (28)
 - 1. Never Intimidated by Opposition
 - a. εν μηδενι = in nothing fearful
 - b. the entire world will oppose you
 - 2. Their opposition is a sign (also their standing firm)
 - a. A sign of their destruction
 - b. A sign of your victory (salvation)
 - c. A sign from God
 - D. This Life is Expected
 - 1. Given to believe and to suffer
 - a. God gave it
 - b. Sure to come
 - 2. Given to all believers
 - a. Paul faced same trials
 - b. We will face the same trials.
