Being Lights in the World (Phil. 2:12-18)

- I. Focus on Working as God Works in You (12-13)
 - A. Continue to Obey in Humility (12)
 - 1. Continue Working Out Your Salvation
 - a. Not just when Paul is present
 - i. True humble service when no one watches
 - ii. True humility seeks no affirmation
 - b. With Fear and Trembling
 - i. Not taking grace for granted
 - ii. Fear and Reverence for God
 - iii. Always examining ourselves and motives
 - 2. Continue Working Out Your Salvation Together
 - a. Command is Plural not singular
 - i. Previous section displays unity
 - ii. the "working" is done in community
 - B. God Continues His Work in You (13)
 - 1. Believer's Work is due to God's Work
 - a. God gives both desire (will) and effort (work)
 - b. God regenerates the heart
 - 2. Believer's work is for God's good pleasure
 - a. We work for Him (not others)
 - b. He gives the desire to work for Him
- II. Focus on Your Unity Before the World (14-16a)
 - A. Keep Your Unity in Humility (14)
 - 1. Do everything without argument or complaint
 - a. This is the opposite of humility
 - b. This is a plural command (community)
 - B. Keep Your Testimony Before the World (15a)
 - 1. Unity in humility makes you blameless and pure
 - a. Not before God
 - b. But before the World
 - 2. Unity in Humility makes you children without blemish
 - 3. Unity in Humility bears Testimony
 - a. To a crooked and perverse generation
 - b. So we shine like lights in the world
 - c. So we hold forth the word of life
 - i. This is how we shine in the world
- III. Focus on the Joy of the Gospel (16b-18)
 - A. Paul's Ministry is proven (16)
 - 1. As Philippians are lights in the world
 - 2. Paul's work in them is proven
 - B. Transformation is Evidence of the Gospel
 - 1. Paul did not labor in vain
 - a. Because Philippians hold as lights in the world
 - b. Remember they work because God works

- C. Paul's Joy in His Trials (17)
 - 1. Paul is being poured out as an offering
 - 2. Paul is imprisoned for the faith
 - 3. Paul considers it nothing compared to their ministry
 - 4. Paul rejoices with them
- D. Paul Desires their Joy (18)
 - 1. they should not despair his imprisonment
 - 2. They should rejoice in the ministry
 - 3. They should rejoice in Paul's suffering role as well.
