## The Effect of False Religion (Zechariah 7)

- I. The Definition of False Religion (1-7)
  - A. False Religion is Brought To Light (1-3)
    - 1. The Jews Ask About Keeping Their Fast on 5th Month(3)
      - a. The Jewish Exiles kept Four Fasts Regarding Jerusalem's Fall
        - i. 9th day of 4th Month Mourned breach of city walls
        - ii. 18<sup>th</sup> day of 5<sup>th</sup> Month Mourned burning of Temple and city
        - iii. 3<sup>rd</sup> day of 7<sup>th</sup> Month Mourned murder of Gedaliah the governor and massacre of 80 men (Jer. 41:1-10)
        - iv.  $10^{\text{th}}$  day of  $10^{\text{th}}$  Month Mourned the day of Nebuchadnezzar setting up his siege around city
      - b. The Jews Saw the Temple Being Restored
      - c. The Jews Saw the Priests and Prophets back in the Land
      - d. The Jews Wanted to Discontinue Their Fast
        - i. The 5<sup>th</sup> Month was mourning the loss of the Temple
        - ii. Since the Temple was being restored they had no need to fast
  - B. False Religion is Reprimanded (4-12a)
    - 1. False Religion Is Regretful Not Repentant (4-5)
      - a. The Jews Fasted For the Wrong Reason
        - i. Their Religion Was Hypocritical
        - ii. Their Mourning was For the Consequences Not the Sin
          - They mourned God's Judgment falling The Temple, Exile, etc.
          - They did not mourn their sin which caused it
      - b. Modern Religion is Often for the Wrong Reason
        - i. Men desire God's Blessing Not God Himself
        - ii. Men Mourn the Consequences Not the Sin
        - iii. Men Use God For Their Own Ends
        - iv. Men View the Gospel as "get out of jail free card"
    - 2. False Religion is Self-Centered (6)
      - a. Their Religious Observances Were Self-Centered
        - i. Their Fasting and Mourning was Self-Pity
        - ii. Their Religion was To Make Them Feel Better
        - iii. Their Religion was to Gain Favor from God
        - iv. Their Religion was about their emotional needs and their religious experience
      - b. Religion Must Be Centered On God
        - i. Religion is a vital Relationship with God
        - ii. Religion is only Through The Mediation of Christ
        - iii. Religion is vain if not for God's pleasure, glory, service, and love

- iv. Are you concerned about sin or the consequences of sin?
- 3. False Religion Rejects God's Word (7)
  - a. God Gave them His Word Through Prophets
  - b. God's Word Was not obeyed
    - i. Men "Seek" God in dire positions, looking for a "new" word or instruction
    - ii. Men have God's infallible Word in Scripture
    - iii. Men Reject the Revelation they have already Received
- 4. False Religion Fails To Follow and Represent God (8-12a)
  - a. God Told the People the Evidence of True Religion (9-10)

NOTE: Not working for true religion but

The Spirit of God working in the believers

- i. Representation of the Attributes of God
  - Exercise True Judgment (Micah 6:8)
  - Show brotherhood and compassion to one another (John 13:35)
  - Do not oppress the needy (James 1:27)
  - Do not Harbor evil against another (1 John 2:9-11; Matt. 5:44)
- ii. God's Spirit Accomplishes This in Believers
  - Speaks of Lifestyle not Perfection
  - Disobedience without chastisement is not possible (Heb. 12:8; Rev 3:19)
- b. The People Rejected God's Instruction (11-12a)
  - i. They Refused to Pay Attention
  - ii. they stubbornly Turned Away
  - iii. They stopped up their ears
  - iv. They hardened their hearts
    - They trusted their own evidence
    - They refused to heed the warnings of God
    - They "followed their hearts"
    - They refused to accept the evidence of their life
    - Today it is the same way
    - As long as we affirm certain truths, we think our lives don't matter (1 John 3:9-10)
    - God calls us to live it, not agree with it
- II. The Consequences of False Religion (12b-14)
  - A. False Religion Receives the Passive Judgment of God (12b-13)
    - 1. The People Received God's Wrath (12b)
      - a. Because They would not listen When God cried out (13)
      - b. God would not listen When they Cried out
    - 2. God Turned them over to the consequences of their actions
    - 3. God would not hear when they finally cried out to Him
    - 4. God Gave them Over (Romans 1:25)

- a. Here His wrath is Passive in that He simply refuses to hear their cries
- B. False Religion Receives the Active Judgment of God (14)
  - 1. God must finally punish rebellion
  - 2. God will "sweep them away in a storm"
  - 3. God caused them to be taken into exile
  - 4. God caused their land to become desolate
    - a. God will punish all sin
    - b. God will never leave justice undone
    - c. Man may escape immediate justice for a time
    - d. Man will not escape justice forever
    - e. Judgment is coming
  - 5. Punishment will either be poured out on the sinner or on the Savior in place of the sinner.
